Pursuant to the provisions of Section 108 and 110 and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act 2013 (“the Act”) read with Rules 20 and 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (as amended from time to time) (“the rules”) and Regulation 44 of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (SEBI Listing Regulations), Secretarial Standard on General Meetings (“SS-2”) issued by the Institute of Company Secretaries of India, other applicable laws and regulations and In terms of the circulars issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Government of India (the “MCA”) vide its General Circular No. 14/2020 dated April 8, 2020, General Circular No. 17/2020 dated April 13, 2020, read with other relevant circulars, including General Circular No. 11/2022 dated December 28, 2022, (the “MCA Circulars”) issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Notice is hereby given that the resolution appended to this notice is proposed to be passed by the members as Special Resolution through remote electronic voting (remote e-voting).

This Postal Ballot is accordingly being initiated in compliance with the MCA Circulars and SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015. Further, as provided in the said MCA Circulars, hard copy of Postal Ballot Notice, Postal Ballot Forms and pre-paid business envelope, will not be sent to the shareholders for this Postal Ballot. The Company will send Postal Ballot Notice by email to all its shareholders who have registered their email addresses with the Company or depository / depository participants and the communication of assent / dissent of the members will only take place through the remote e-voting system.

The Board of Directors of the Company proposes to obtain the consent of the shareholders by way of Postal Ballot for the matter as considered in the Resolution appended below. Proposed resolution, along with explanatory statement pertaining to the said resolution, pursuant to Section 102(1) of the Companies Act, 2013, setting out the information and material facts, is appended herewith for your consideration.

Shareholders are requested to carefully read the instructions indicated in this Notice and communicate their assent (for) or dissent (against) through remote e-voting only. 2. In compliance with the provisions of Sections 108 and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013, read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management & Administration) Rules, 2014, the Company is pleased to offer remote e-voting facility to all members of the Company. The Company has entered into an agreement with Central Depository Services (India) Limited (“CDSL”) for facilitating remote e-voting.
3. Voting rights shall be reckoned in proportion to the number of shares registered in the name(s) of Members as on Friday, May 26, 2023.
4. Only those Members whose names are appearing in the Register of Members / List of Beneficial Owners as on the Cut-Off Date shall be eligible to cast their votes through postal ballot by remote e-voting. ITEM NO. 1:

Ratification of Material Related Party Transaction(S) Entered with Ganesh Flour Mills:- Special Resolution

Pursuant to the Provisions of Section 188 of the Companies Act, 2013 ('the Act') read with related Rules thereunder state that any related party transaction in relation to sale, purchase or supply of goods or material, directly or through appointment of agent amounting to or exceeding 10% or more of the turnover of the Company as per the audited financial statement for the preceding financial year shall not be entered into by the company except with the prior approval of the Company by a resolution. In the apparent case, it may be noted that the Annual Turnover of the Company as on March 31, 2022 (The Audited Financials of the Company for the Preceding Financial Year) was Rs 184.80 Crores and the Related Party Transactions entered into by Company during FY 2022-23 with Ganesh Flour Mills was for Rs. 19.76 Crores (Purchases- 19.71 and Sales 5.27 Crores) and therefore a material Related Party transaction (Constituting 10.70 % of Annual Turnover of Preceding Financial Year). It crossed the Limit of Material Related Party Transaction in the Last Quarter of Financial Year 2022-23.
